Fact Sheet for Virginia DAR Scholarship Applicants

Listed below are the scholarships awarded by the Virginia DAR to high school seniors from a Virginia high school or home school program who plan to continue their education at Virginia colleges and universities.

- Scholarships are awarded based on academic merit, potential for success, and financial need.
- No affiliation with the Virginia DAR or National Society is necessary to qualify for these scholarships. *Children of DAR members are also eligible.*
- Scholarships are awarded to United States citizens regardless of race, religion, gender, or national origin.

- Applicants to a Virginia Community College transition program leading to a four-year degree are eligible to apply.

Virginia DAR Scholarships — All Majors

Awarded to a high school senior who plans to work towards an undergraduate degree in a field other than nursing. Four awards of \$2,500 each.

Nursing Scholarships

Awarded to a high school senior who will continue her/his education at an accredited Virginia school of nursing. Two awards of \$2,500 each.

National DAR Scholarships

Applicants are encouraged to consider the separate national DAR scholarship program (see <http://www.dar.org>). All applications for national scholarships must follow the separate national instructions.

APPLICATION FORMS

DEADLINE: Scholarship applications must be received in a hard copy by the Virginia DAR Scholarship State Chairman at the address (top of screen) **on or before January 12th. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.** *Electronic applications are not permitted.*

Winners are announced at the Virginia DAR State Conference in March. Winners will be notified by mail prior to the state conference; no other notifications are made. State winners will be asked to submit a photo (head and shoulders) after notification of award. All scholarship checks are sent in late summer and are made payable to the institution the recipient will be attending.
